

Summer Residential Programme

The Elizabeth Foundation has been supporting deaf children and their families since 1981. We provide educational, practical and emotional support to families of deaf children aged 0-5 in a family-centred and fun environment.

Monday 7th – Friday 11th August 2017

Our Summer Residential Programme is aimed at pre-school deaf children (2.5 to 5 years old) and their families. It will consist of:

- ◆ Daily fun-packed and educational pre-school sessions for the deaf children, delivered by qualified and experienced Teachers of the Deaf - a great opportunity for the children to play and learn with other deaf children their age
- ◆ A full and fun-packed sibling programme including outings for siblings aged 5-11years.
- ◆ An informative programme for parents including talks, a range of activities, group and 1:1 discussions, all delivered by qualified and highly experienced staff - plus Q&A sessions with deaf young adults about their experiences of growing up with a hearing loss



During the week your deaf child will also benefit from individual assessments by:

- A Teacher of the Deaf
- An Audiologist
- An Educational Psychologist
- A Specialist Speech and Language Therapist - HI

Each of these will prepare a written report specifically for your child outlining strengths and needs.



The programme will be run at our purpose-built Family Centre in Portsmouth, Hampshire. The cost is £500 per pre-school child in nursery. Sessions will run daily from 9:30am - 14:30pm

Please note that this does not include accommodation, but there are a range of options for this which we can discuss with you.
