

Lesson 1 – How do we hear?

| Resource | Notes |
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| Lesson Plan | Outlines structure & function of 3 sections of outer middle and inner ear. Contains answers to labelled diagrams, how do we hear cut and stick and 2 video links. Cognito video overlaps with Science curriculum, TED Video better for older years. Can be printed using Poster Files |
| Colour in Ear Diagram | Students can colour in Outer/Middle/Inner Ear |
| How we hear Flowchart | Card sort/Cut & Stick. Good for a starter and encourages thinking about a process. May be an individual or a team task. |
| Ear Diagram (for labelling) | Can be printed A4 or A3. Use with Structure and Function Labels. |
| How we Hear gap Fill | Follow up to flowchart. Good for plenary to see how much they have remembered |
| Structure & Function Labels | For use with Ear Diagram. |
| Wordscramble | End of lesson resource to help with recognition of key terms |
| Structure & Function CrossWord | End of lesson resource to help with recognition of key terms |
| Wordsearch | End of lesson resource to help with recognition of key terms |

Suggested Order:

- Starter: Give students 'How we Hear' cards and ask them to sort them into the correct order. Can be individual or group task.
- Watch Cognito video on how ear works and run through structure and function of 3 areas of ear.
- Students complete ear labelling either in groups or individually (Suggestion *if in groups print Ear Diagram to A3 and laminate to create a reusable resource). Check answers and complete individual sheet.
- Watch Video 2 (TED Talk) if deemed appropriate. Complete remaining activities and worksheets as time permits.
