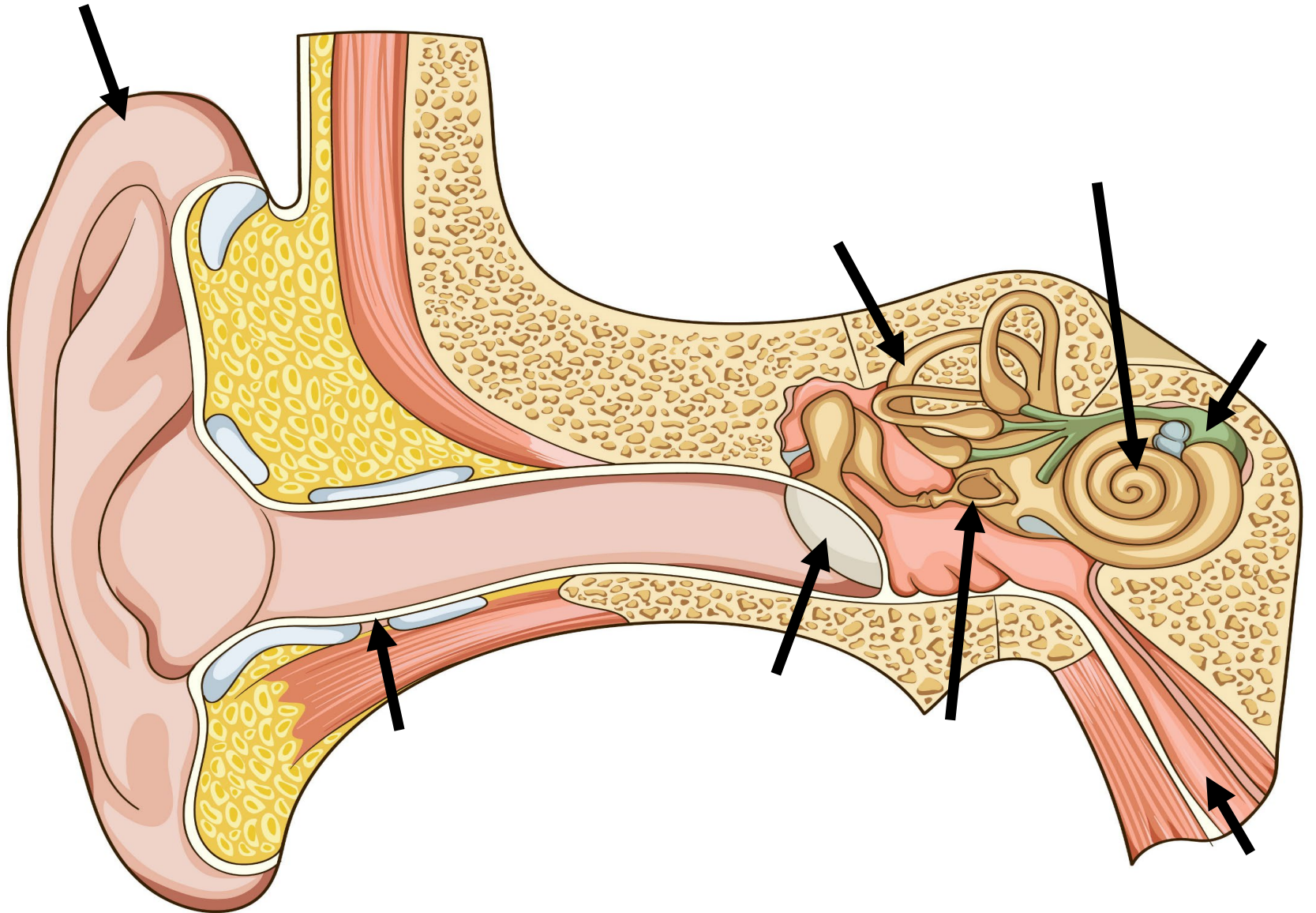


Cut out the boxes and use them to label the parts of the ear with their name and function



<p>Funnels sound waves into the ear canal</p>	<p>Carries nerve impulses generated by the cochlear to the auditory complex in the brain.</p>	<p>Equalises pressure between the ear and the outside world</p>	<p>Detects position and motion to help you balance</p>
<p>Vibrates and generates wave like movements in the fluid inside the cochlear</p>	<p>Vibrates when sound waves reach it</p>	<p>Produces wax to help protect the ear</p>	<p>Contains microscopic hairs that respond to differences in frequency and pitch</p>
<p>PINNA</p>	<p>AUDITORY NERVE</p>	<p>EUSTACHIAN TUBE</p>	<p>SEMI-CIRCULAR CANALS</p>
